

Exceptional three-bedroom duplex apartment.

An exceptional three-bedroom apartment spanning over 1400 sq ft arranged across the Ground Floor and Courtyard levels of the building. The apartment entrance features a mirror-fronted storage facility with steps down to the open-plan kitchen and reception space with panelled walls and ornate up-lighting coffer-coved ceiling.

Dual-aspect doors open out to the courtyard terrace which is also accessible via the bedrooms and the beautifully decorated study. The master bedroom has a range of built-in wardrobes, a full marble en suite bathroom with underfloor heating, mirror-fronted cabinet units with integrated demister, and a door leading to the private courtyard. The second bedroom also offers a range of built-in wardrobes and an en suite marble shower room whilst bedroom 3 opens out onto the private terrace. All bedrooms come with Samsung smart TVs with Sonos soundbars and comfort cooling.

Kensington Area

One of London's most expensive and desired areas, Kensington is bordered to the north by Notting Hill and by Cromwell Road to the south.

A few of Kensington's tourist attractions are the multiple museums along Exhibition Road where you can find the Victoria and Albert Museum, The Science Museum and Natural History Museum. For cultural events, there is The Royal Albert Hall on the northern edge of South Kensington, which has held the Proms concerts annually each summer since 1941.




